- 2. SCHOOL REPORTS. Ask your school counselor to send your transcripts and other records, as well as a teacher recommendation to the Scholarship Committee. These records should arrive in one package.
- 3. COLLEGE STUDENTS. Please send your high school transcript to the Scholarship Committee along with your college transcript.
- 3. COMMUNITY RECOMMENDATION. Ask a member of our Church Community to write a recommendation on your behalf. This recommendation should be sent directly to the committee.
